## Soror Madie Simpson

On August 3, 2009 Soror Madie Simpson was called to her heavenly home. Soror Simpson became a member of Zeta Phi Beta Sorority, Inc. in 1943 as an undergraduate and later joined the Delta Zeta Chapter where she served as President of Delta Zeta for a number of years. Soror Simpson spearheaded Delta Zeta's organizing of the Zeta Amicae Auxiliary on April 16, 1978. She was also the first female to be elected to serve as the Financial Secretary of the AME Zion Church and held this position for 54 years. As current members celebrate 75 years of existence in the Queen City, we know that had it not been for the work of sorors, such as Soror Madie Simpson, in the early years of the chapter, we would not be where we are today.
